Registration continues daily as long as class openings are available. Children who vacation during the summer are also welcome to enroll. The Boating and Sailing Program offers instruction for all levels from beginner boaters through advanced boaters. In addition adults can take advantage of their leisure schedule to take the whole family sailing. The adult and family schedule is Saturdays and Sundays from 12:00 noon to 5:30 p.m. This program is designed so that the entire family may participate and develop boating skills and enjoy valuable family time on the waters of Quincy. Adults interested in boating and sailing lessons may inquire at the Boathouse for individual lessons and appointment availability.
